Gabrielle Bonheur Chanel was born in 1883, being the second born of six children. She was from a poor family, her mother being a laundry woman and her father a street vendor of clothes and undergarments. When Gabrielle was only eleven, her mother died and she was sent to a convent, where she learned to sew. After six years in the convent, Gabrielle worked as a seamstress and sang in a cabaret. During her time singing, she often sang a song called "Who has seen Coco?", giving her this nickname. Coco Chanel had an interesting life, that led her to create sporty and casual style clothes for women, with an elegant touch. Her style in fashion was a huge contrast when compared to the popular corseted silhouette style that had been very present in wardrobes of women. As a fashion designer, she made a huge impact on women's fashion, not only in France, but all over the world.
