Most people love to give and receive gifts at Christmas. However, not everybody has the same budget in order to buy gifts. Some people have more money and others less money. So, what can you do if you have a tight budget? **One of the best things to do is to plan ahead of time how much money you will probably have to spend and how much of it will go to each person.** That way you don't overspend. Something else you might be able to do is to **start buying early because then you can get good deals**. Also, if you like to make things, it is a good concept to make your own Christmas gifts. Some people are going to do this for their next Christmas gifts and **they can save up to half of the money** than what they would have bought in a shop or online. **Make sure to compare if it is cheaper to make it or not first.** **Something smart to do is to only pay in cash**, that way you don't accidentally spend more than what you wanted to. Another thing that you can do is **buy in bulk because of the money you can save**. **If you buy in quantity, you will be able to make some really special and personal gift baskets** as presents. Moreover, you can choose to buy a smaller gift or **buy a combined gift that is more expensive** with other people, and perhaps save money too! Furthermore, you don't have to buy a lot of gifts. Just make sure that if you buy one or two gifts it is a good quality gift. Finally, you mustn't just buy the first thing you see. Hunt around because **you might find it cheaper in another place**, which will help you save money too.

9	What could you do if you don't buy a lot of gifts?	buy (one or two) good quality gifts.
10	Why should you hunt around before buying a gift?	find it cheaper (in another place)
