In addition to this, many celebrities state that the best thing about being famous is that they are recognized wherever they go. Many celebrities love to connect with their fans who adore them. Also, one of the main advantages is that most famous people have more opportunities available to them. This could be from sending their children to the most exclusive private schools, to going on exotic holidays in faraways countries or having more work opportunities that allow them to meet other famous individuals that they would otherwise not get the chance to meet.

So to continue, there are certainly some aspects that are not so favorable. For instance, despite having many doors open to them, a well-known person is more limited in the things they can do compared to common day people. They may not be able to spend a day out with their family or go on a date without being sought after by the press. An additional consequence to being famous is that although they are loved by their fans, they might also bring forth other unwanted attention and attract stalkers.
