This is a map of a **train station**. Here, it shows north, south, east and west (point to compass on map). You're going to hear someone talking about the **train station**. You'll hear the talk twice. These pictures (point to the pictures) show some places in the **train station**. The talk will tell you where the places are. Each picture has a letter. Write the correct letter in the circles on the map. There is one circle you do not need to use. There's an example to show you what to do (point to where it says A on the map). Please look at the map and the pictures now. You have 15 seconds (wait 15 seconds). Are you ready?

Audio script

There is an information point in the north-east corner of the train station. In the middle of the train station, there is a kiosk. Next to it, on the left, there is a coffee shop. Cash machines can be found in the south-east corner of the train station. In the north-west corner, opposite of the cash machines, there is a book shop. Between the book shop and information point, you can find the trains. Opposite to it, to the south of the building, that is where you can buy a ticket to catch the train.
