2	How old is Henry?	6 / Six years old
3	What do they have to buy?	(new) clothes (for school) / uniforms
4	What colour are their uniforms?	blue and grey
5	What special clothes does Karen need?	a dungaree and a skirt
6	What special clothes does Henry need?	(a pair of) trousers and shorts
